Graduate and Faculty Ministry in Metro-NYC provide spaces for graduate students, post-docs, fellows, and faculty to encounter God, grow in friendships and community, and learn more about how the Christian faith is relevant to every aspect of their lives, including their studies and professions. As a GFM staff, I am planting and growing witnessing communities of grad students and faculty to embrace the following ministry commitments in reliance of the Holy Spirit:

1. Spiritual Formation
2. Community
3. Evangelism & Service
4. Integration of Faith, Learning & Practice.

Your partnership will help me meet these folks to encourage and equip them as they seek to be a redeeming influence among the people, ideas, and structures of the university and professions.

2022 has been a challenging year of ministry. It's been a year full of various current events that have affected students and communities on campus. One of the questions we were asked is: Is the Gospel still Good News? The simple answer is YES, of course! However, it has been tough for students to initiate spiritual conversations with their peers because if we are honest with ourselves, sometimes we personally don't believe it to be true. Our staff teams spent this summer focusing on the passage of 2 Corinthians 4, and I've personally been challenged to think more deeply about what God wants/desires for our ministry in this new school year.

Our focus this fall is to continue meeting graduate students all across Metro-NYC and inviting them to consider the Gospel to be Good News, and how following Jesus can transform their lives as they pursue their academics and vocation.

OCM Supported Missionary: ZEG

Thank you, OCM, for your continuous support that has made it possible for us to share the gospel with our Muslim neighbors here and mobilize local believers to do the same. Our burden is specifically for reaching the 50,000 Taboks, an unreached Muslim group in East Asia. A big part of our frontline ministry is frequenting Halal restaurants throughout the city to build relationships with the Taboks. In addition, we live in a

“global gateway city” (全球福音門戶城市) where foreigners from all over the world come to study and work. There is also a quarter million Indonesian migrant workers here, many of whom had to learn the basics of the trade language to perform their jobs. This has made it possible for us to share the message of God’s love and truth with them. The harvest is plentiful; the workers are few. We continue to work with the local churches to mobilize and build up believers to join us in this work, encouraging them to engage in cross-cultural missions “right outside their doorstep” (家門前的宣教).

Ministry Update: This year was full of exciting new opportunities. Our team kick-started a new resource development project specifically for reaching the Box – the unreached people group that we have been called to serve. The training materials – written articles, e-books, and a 3-day ethnographic course – have been circulating among Box workers with very positive responses thus far. In August, we taught a course on cross-cultural missions to workers in C-land as part of their pre-field and on-field training. It was such a blessing to walk alongside them in their struggles and victories as they sow among very hard soil.

2022-2023 Plans: This Fall will be a time of transition as we prepare for our home assignment at the end of this year. We will be passing the baton for the mentoring of our Journey group made up of local brothers and sisters with a call to cross-cultural work. We plan to spend the first half of 2023 in the US for rest and re-connection with partners, friends, and family. It will also be a time for us to discern the Father’s will for where he would have us continue serving the Box people after our home assignment.

Prayer Requests:

- a) Pray for the local believers we have been discipling to continue to pursue their call to cross-cultural work despite existing barriers.
- b) Pray for the All4Box Project to continue providing practical resources for training of current and prospective workers to reach Box people.
- c) Pray for a restful home assignment and clarity in our next steps.



H.O.P.E. Bible
Mission: Directors:
Rick & Deb Carey;
Guatemala, Central
America

H.O.P.E. Bible Mission serves in Guatemala, Central America. The national team seeks to foster programs that focus entirely on underserved communities which have severely limited access to Biblical training, education, and healthcare. Working in partnership with AGAPE, a small plane aviation ministry based in Guatemala City, H.O.P.E. helps give physical access and spiritual edification to pastors, churches, and teachers in the Quiché mountain region of Guatemala. H.O.P.E. focuses on Biblical Leadership training, youth training, and a Firm Foundations program for teachers of children in the local churches. Run:Hope is our education initiative to give training to teachers and support to students to access a middle school education. We have three Run:Hope partner schools that serve approximately 250 students and 22 teachers.

After the first months of 2022 proved challenging with COVID limitations, our national team was able to be vaccinated and all ministry areas are now moving forward. Our traveling "Bible Seminary" is once again providing teaching and resources in three training centers with 65 pastors and lay leaders participating. Our Run:Hope education initiative is helping 264 students stay in school this year in three mountain communities and 27 teachers to receive training, encouragement, and resources for their schools. A.G.A.P.E. aviation ministry is very active providing transport and medical relief flights to difficult to access areas in Guatemala.

The new year kicks off with our Run:Hope teacher conference in early January 2023. The new school year begins mid-January and our goal is to see 300 students sponsored to be able to continue their education. The Bible training program is working to open an additional training center in another area of great need. The A.G.A.P.E. aviation ministry continues to strengthen with two additional pilots in the process of intensive training and certification. We thank God and OCM for your faithful support and ask you to remember the following requests in your prayers for H.O.P.E.

Supporting us in prayer

- 1) Pray for spiritual and physical health and strength for each member of our national team. (7 couples and 5 individuals) Even before COVID times, travel and work in the Quiché region is physically demanding.
- 2) Pray for our three Run:Hope partner schools in the Quiché region as they finish their school year in October and plan for the new year to begin mid-January 2023. Pray that the Bible training program is able to open an additional center for 2023.
- 3) Pray for Deb Carey as she develops and directs the Run:Hope conference for January 2023 and helps prepare the national team for the Firm Foundations program: Creation to Christ, in Salquil Grande, Quiché.

PIONEERS

We (the “Abu Khalil” Family) are with Pioneers International. Pioneers mobilizes teams to glorify God among unreached peoples by initiating church-planting movements in partnership with local churches. We work in the Middle East, and our ministry is focused on reaching Arabic speaking Muslims in North Africa and the Middle East with the gospel, disciple making movements and training National believers in Christ from both Christian and Muslim backgrounds to fulfil the Great Commission. “Rafik” is both the head of Maarifa, (a project of our Media Department) and the area leader for two countries in our North Africa Middle East Region, and “Cindy” works in Media as a graphic designer.

From January through August 2022, our Media Ministry has seen 159 new Christian believers from the Arab World; 14 of them are already sharing their faith. We have 6,491 contacts who are active in communicating with us, and 148 individuals have begun to study the Bible with us. 66 contacts have joined Zoom Bible study/fellowship groups. There have been 7,521 downloads of the Arabic Bible, and 20 new believers have been baptized. Through our Arab Christian training and equipping in evangelism and missions ministry, we have seen 36 house churches planted, and 27 national Christians sent to the mission field in the Arab World.

Our goals for the Training Ministry next year include: Training 60 additional Arab Christians in evangelism, discipleship and mission. We hope to send 25 more Arab missionaries to the field. In our Media Ministry, we are praying to see 1 new believer each day. We plan to disciple over 75 new believers online on Zoom. We also are in the process of creating new content to reach out specifically to Arab women, content to be used at the Virtual Reality VR, and content especially designed for the people of Sudan and Chad.

Prayer Requests:

1. Media Ministry: To find the right young people with skills in technology and the virtual reality fields to join us.
2. Training Ministry: That we train the right people who have both a passion for God, and a passion for reaching out to Arab Muslims.
3. Personal: Please pray for our son, who graduated from college last year and is still looking for a job, and our daughter who has started college and is feeling very homesick and out of place in the American culture after growing up in the Middle East.



Chinese Gospel Broadcasting Center USA (CGBC)

CGBC was registered in 1979 in London and 1983 in New York City. Our goal remains to reach Chinese people with the gospel message. Our special concern has been for those working overseas in factories, restaurants, supermarkets, even on ocean liners and fishing fleets. Our vision is to provide tools for

Christians (mostly intellectual and middle-class professionals) to bring Jesus to their Chinese-speaking parents and elderly family members. In the 70s we used cassette tapes since portable cassette recorders were popular. From the 80s to the 90s we produced radio programs for Chinese radio stations in NY, LA, Dallas and Sydney. Since 1999 we have developed the Life Broadcasting Network with four channels: Mandarin, Cantonese, Music and English channels, to broadcast online at www.cgbc.net

Chinese Gospel Broadcasting Center (CGBC) is in transition in 2022. For 20 years the Center in Hong Kong provided daily online streaming of the Life Broadcast through www.CGBC.net. But since March of this year, we have been required to explore new mode of operation in response to the demand of new government policies.

The Board of Directors of CGBC in the US is at present working diligently with the founders and current managers of the ongoing ministries of CGBC from Hong Kong, even as one of the founders is now on Sabbatical through September. We strive to continue our mission without interruption.

At present, workers in Taiwan under Andrina Kan's leadership, in LA under Penny Ito, and in Hong Kong under the Founder's supervision, remain faithful in developing contents for Gospel broadcasting, completing the scripts of radio dramas and editing the interviews of mature Christians, laymen as well as those in long-time ministries. Those efforts are not interrupted.

We are in the process of discerning the guidance from the Lord in light of the changing geopolitical climate, the advance of media technology, the identifying of target people groups and audience, and the Lord calling suitable workers to leadership, technical service, and ministries. We seek to continue the furtherance of the Gospel in order to fulfill the vision and mission entrusted to the founders over 40 years ago. We covet your prayers for CGBC in these areas.

Chinese Overseas Christian Mission

Reaching the Chinese to reach Europe. Evangelizing and discipling foreign students, immigrants, 2nd generation, and nurturing believers in the UK and Europe through partnership with churches and parachurch organizations. Equipping them to plant and develop churches/fellowships and to serve their communities. Encouraging disciples to share the gospel both intra-culturally and cross-culturally throughout the UK, Europe and beyond in their home countries.

I primarily serve Mandarin-speaking students and young working adults in the UK and Europe. Besides helping with centralized conferences, I support several local fellowships and churches by providing teaching materials as well as sharing or preaching in person itinerantly. Other parts of my ministry include leading STEP Pro (young working adults ministry), supporting a Chinese church in north London regularly and hosting a YouTube channel recommending Christian literature.

As Covid restriction eases, most of our ministries are back to normal; hence, we were able to organize three relatively large-scale physical conferences: Year-end student evangelistic camp, Easter student discipleship camp and Mandarin Summer Camp. Besides conferences, we've been exploring how to best equip brothers and sisters with more focused training courses. So far this year, we've offered one Mandarin online course on Genesis and one Cantonese physical training weekend on counselling. The COCM Training Center is a new ministry initiative so there are many areas that need development, both in infrastructures such as the website and in the actual training program such as curriculum planning and resource database building. Therefore, most of my energy would be devoted to this program; meanwhile, I'll also support a Mandarin congregation in London regularly.

Prayer Requests:

- 1) COCM Training Center: Coordinating the training center is a new challenge for me. So please pray for wisdom from above as I make decisions in its development so that this new ministry project would be beneficial for brothers and sisters in the mission field.
- 2) Church support: The mandarin service at the church I regularly support has finally resumed after a two-year pause due to Covid and personnel change. Please pray that God would stir up more people's hearts to build up the body of Christ together and to share the gospel with the community.
- 3) Personal prayer request: From this September, I would start a part-time studies on Christianity and the Arts. Please pray that God would use this program to enrich my understanding of Him and to better equip me to serve more creatively in the future.

are doing Mandarin-speaking student ministry with COCM in the UK. Our priority is leading two campus fellowships covering three universities. Two universities in the midland city of the UK called Leicester, and another one is Cranfield University, which is 20 minutes driving from

COCM Headquarter. The work includes guiding the Mandarin-speaking University students to seek for God, to know God and to longing for God. This is achieved by various approaches such as Bible study, personal evangelism, pastoral caring, discipleship training and so forth. We also support other Mandarin ministry in COCM such as camp ministry, gospel team, and preaching in Chinese Churches.

Since we had three kids in the past three years (including new-born brother and sister twins in May), our ministries have changed significantly from nationwide to local. Cranfield University is 15-min drive from COCM headquarter, COCM founded the Mandarin students fellowship in 2019, together with Cranfield University Christian Union and the local Milton Keynes Chinese Christian Church. Our current main ministry is leading that fellowship. Apart from that, we are also helping the Mandarin congregation in Milton Keynes Chinese Christian Church, our ministries including leading Bible studies, Sunday preaching and church member-care.

The new university academic year starts in the Fall. Several welcoming events in Cranfield University Mandarin Student Fellowship are under planning. Additionally, in the coming year, we will spend more time in pastoring the Mandarin congregation in Milton Keynes Chinese Christian Church. And at the same time, Xu will continue his part-time theology study in the London School of Theology.

- 1) Please pray for the welcoming events in Cranfield University Mandarin Student Fellowship, Praise the Lord that the fellowship has several committed co-workers. May Lord bless our team and use the fellowship to be the blessings of the new Chinese students in the coming academic year.
- 2) Please pray for our new pastor role in the Mandarin congregation in Milton Keynes Chinese Christian Church. It is a new experience for us. May God use us and give us wisdom to build-up the church.

Tim, Rosie and Adora

are based in Milton Keynes, serving at COCM mission center.

Our ministries include three major parts: student ministry, church supporting and new media. Tim and Rosie lead a campus student fellowship in central London and support the Chinese Church in London New Soho Congregation (leading worship, leading Bible study and preaching). Tim also coordinates 'Living Water' new media ministry, including an online Christian magazine (COCM活水文字- Living Water Ministry (livingwatercocm.org)) and a podcast (渔舟畅聊). Besides helping centralized conferences, Tim coordinates COCM Mandarin Student Ministry Forum and makes videos for COCM general director's monthly sharing.

Rosie took the lead of the Light & Life mandarin student fellowship in London last September. Besides regular meetings, Rosie and the core team of the fellowship organized two evangelistic events during the Chinese New Year of 2022 and more than 60 people came and heard the Gospel. Tim focused more on church ministry by serving at a Chinese church in London city center, including preaching, training and mentoring. Both Tim and Rosie served in the three large physical post-pandemic conferences: Year-end student evangelistic camp, Easter student discipleship camp and Mandarin Summer Family Camp.

As Rosie is in pregnancy, Tim will take the lead of the Light & Life Mandarin student fellowship. We are planning a series of welcoming events for the newcomers. Tim will also help the church start a new plan for Sunday services so as to form a more cohesive serving team.

Great Commission: **Mak and Narola Sanglir**

Our ministry is holistic, focusing on the Hmong people in Nan Province, North Thailand whose religious background is animist and spirit worship. We are involved in evangelism, church planting, discipleship making, leadership training, member care, and children and youth ministry. The Lord led us to start The Firm Foundation (TFF), which focuses on reaching out to children from Grade 1 to university students. Currently, Kathy's Home (KH) in Pua, House of Hope (HOH) in Thawangpha and Beacon Hall (BH) in Chiangmai are registered under this foundation. We minister at KH, Monday through Friday and go to the Hmong villages on Sat- Sun for weekend ministry.

Kathy's Home:

The school year started with 32 students from 9 villages. Many of them come from unbelieving families. The two youngest siblings came from a broken family. Their parents are divorced and were left alone with their older siblings. We rescued HER (9) and HIM (6) and brought them to Kathy's Home.

Village Ministry:

Suchat, our alumni from Kathy's Home heard the call of God. We sent him to Bible school and now he is back in the village, pastoring the church. He is also committed to come to Kathy's Home, 2 days a week to teach Bible to the children.

We are committed to have quarterly English camp at Kathy's Home for our children followed by a VBS before the end of school year. The English camp will help them to prepare for their future studies in different colleges.

Prayer Requests:

- 1) Please pray that the children at Kathy's Home may come to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior as we teach His Word.
- 2) Please pray for the churches that they will continually reach out in their villages and witness for Christ.
- 3) Please pray for Mak, Narola and our co-workers, that we may have the same mind and burden to reach out to the children and show the love to Christ through our lives.



New York Short Term Mission: **Min. Audrey Chan**

Thank you OCM for supporting and praying for New York Short-Term Mission (NYSTM) always. OCM and NYSTM have been mission partners in evangelism for many years. NYSTM was established in 1993 which is almost 28 years ago. NYSTM's mission is to train believers to be preachers and fulfill the Great Commission throughout their lives. Our Goal is to raise up believers to spread the gospel through Short-term training and Long-term mission. Time flies. 2022 seems to have started not long ago but it is already October now. This is also the Mission Month of OCM.

With a grateful heart, let's review NYSTM's ministries in the past three quarter

- 1) Over the pandemic, our newspaper Truth Monthly turned into its digital version. With the return of in-person worship in churches, we have resumed publishing the hardcopies since this January, while the online version continues to be issued through mobile phones, Facebook and our web page.
- 2) Our two-year part-time Evangelical Certification Training Class (Spring semester) continues via online lessons and video call for evangelical outreaches.
- 3) Met with church leaders to organize the "Lighten Up Life" and "Jesus Loves Chinatown" evangelical outreach week in June and August respectively. All the training workshops were conducted online. The outreaches were done both with video calls and in-person community programs. "Jesus Loves Chinatown" climaxed and concluded with the children's carnivore on 8/28, when families were reached with the gospel and fun activities. Praise the Lord for spreading the seeds of his truth.
- 4) Hosting the sidewalk Gospel Station with OCMers outside the church building on Hester Street every Sunday this year. Two evangelical training classes had also been held, one was on Saturday between January to February and the other on Sunday between July and August. Participants immediately practiced what they had learned on the street after the classes.

In the fourth quarter, the Evangelical Certification Training Class (Fall semester) will continue both online and in-person, with physical out-reach practices. (The instructors will conduct the classes and lead the out-reaches themselves.) October 29th is the 29th Annual Thanksgiving Luncheon and New Staff Inauguration of NYSTM. December shall have our Winter Evangelical Outreach Day.

Prayer Requests:

- 1) Our 29th Annual Thanksgiving Luncheon and New Staff Inauguration – pray for participations and revival of leaders and disciples alike.
- 2) The Evangelical Certification Training Class graduates – pray for their commitment and energy to continue to serve the Lord.
- 3) Our 2023 new co-workers Min. Lee/Li and Mrs. Lee/Li – pray for their transition into and partnership with NYSTM to serve the Lord.



Development Associates International (DAI)

DAI's basic approach is to listen first, research the real needs of leaders, then design tools that respond to those needs effectively and begin putting in place an indigenous distribution system to enable leaders to access those tools. Every course DAI has written came about this way, including the popular Master of Arts in Organizational Leadership (MAOL) program. Local Christian leaders grow in their integrity and effectiveness through ongoing training, mentoring, consulting and access to critical resources. DAI's programs continue to grow and evolve as new needs are identified or needs change. DAI has 38 ministry centers with full-time staff focused on serving their area's needs. We currently work in over 80 countries, which we have organized into nine regions – East Africa, West Africa, Francophone Africa, Eurasia, East Asia, South Asia, Latin America, Middle East/North Africa and North America.

Cindy in South East Asia

Updates of the 1st 3 quarters of ministry for this year (2022)

- Coordinating DAI's 'Compassion in Crisis' relief response through our national ministry centers and closely related leaders in Haiti, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Myanmar and Pakistan.
- Facilitating 'Trauma Healing' groups among NE Indian women leaders; equipping and mentoring national S Asian leaders as Trauma Healing facilitators, slowly multiplying the impact throughout the region
- Facilitating Spiritual Formation 'Walking Together' retreat with DAI S & SE Asian senior leaders from 8 countries, and prep for 2nd retreat in Oct.
- Spent 4 months mid-year in the US alongside my sister who had returned from China with her husband for his final few months with family before his death — a privilege to walk this journey with them.

Future plans for our ministry in the Fall and the upcoming year

- Return to India and spend final quarter of 2022 in South Asia — continuing expansion of 'Trauma Healing' groups and training-mentoring of national facilitators; and coordination of DAI 'Compassion in Crisis' relief response resourcing DAI related leaders.
- Travel to meet mentees around S Asia in their places of ministry — to encourage, consult, and 'love on them' in the power of His love.

Prayer requests

- New Indian visa needed by end of 2022 — discernment of God's purposes for me in the coming year, as I seek to walk with Him.
- 2023 I hope to hand over both my DAI roles in Compassion in Crisis, and Trauma Healing to younger leaders, and give more time to simply coming alongside/mentoring several key S Asian leaders whom God has given me the privilege of walking with.

Our mission at Women of Wonder!

(WOW!) is to build a community that walks alongside women to uncover and affirm their God-given calling through prayer, teaching, and celebration in hopes of fulfilling our vision to see sisters soar. Our ministries reflect our values of DISCOVERY (we are committed to the ongoing journey of discovering who God is and who we are), HOSPITALITY (we embody God's heart of hospitality through unhurried welcome, acceptance, and engagement) and PRESENCE (we invite you into generous and compassionate attentiveness to others, to self, and to God. Our presence to one another seeks to lovingly honor every story as part of God's story). We carry out the vision, mission, and values in partnership with churches and organizations in caring for and sustaining their leaders through our monthly Biblical teaching seminars, silent retreats, prayer support, and spiritual care ministries. WOW! believes this will help the Church to flourish to the fullness of its calling in affirming God's call to leadership and discipleship for every individual with the hopes of men and women being able to lead alongside one another to further God's kingdom here on earth.

WOW! has been deepening and expanding on the work and relationships God has given us to steward in caring for and sustaining women and men seeking to deepen their walk with the Lord through our ministries.

Our monthly Biblical teaching seminars have focused on Ezer Communities, building upon last year's theme of Exploration of Ezer while making the teachings available to a larger audience via our Women Biblical Leadership podcast. We continue virtual offerings for silent retreats, 1-on-1 or group spiritual direction/spiritual discernment sessions and monthly prayer gatherings. In addition, we have hosted 2 hybrid seminars, 2 in-person Refresh silent retreats, and 2 Soul Care cohort reunions. We celebrated the completion of 3 year-long mentoring matches and hosted a space for 2 diverse groups of women to journey more intentionally together through the Lent season. Overall, our gatherings impact an average of 8-12 people each and we offer sustained, regular prayer support and engagement with 15-20 women serving in various ministry settings.

We have been present in supporting our local community in planning and participating in a Chinatown prayer vigil in February of this year and partnering alongside NYCAAPIC, OCM, and other NYC churches for a walk of solidarity and prayer in May. This fall we will be launching into a busy ministry season; finishing out our last quarter of monthly seminars looking at Justice in Action within Ezer Communities. Our 4th Soul Care Cohort and a longer, 8 month initiative in group spiritual direction will begin in October. This opportunity along with hosting our first in-person 1 day retreat on Discerning and Discovering will allow us to continue exploring and growing with some previous members of the cohort and others interested in this form of group care. We are in the midst of planning for our 10 year anniversary celebration where we will honor WOW! founder, Rev. Grace May. Throughout this year, we have seen a wide range of people come to WOW!, from missionaries, pastors, lay leaders, seminarians, professors, campus ministers, those seeking, those deconstructing and reconstructing: as we look toward 2023 we will be evaluating ways we can effectively offer spaces of discovery, rest and reflection, and care for those God sends our way.

Ministry Updates:

- 2) Discovery Bible Study with a graduate student from India resulted in him proclaiming Jesus as his Only God!
- 3) Cindy co-led an international student Parent Support Group. One the moms began to follow Jesus! Their family began to attend Vision Church. Last month, her husband accepted Jesus as His Lord and Savior!
